ELGIN — “An Inspector Calls,” the classic British detective mystery by J. B. Priestly, opens Oct. 25 at the Hale Turner Little Theatre in Elgin.

The play runs through Nov. 3, with performances at 7:30 p.m. Fridays and Saturdays, Saturday matinees at 2:30 p.m., and a Sunday matinee Nov. 3 at 2:30 p.m. Tickets are \$17.

The intriguing plot centers around the wealthy Birling family and a mysterious crime. The enigmatic police inspector who arrives at the Birling home to investigate shines his light not only on the family but on society as well, in the process drawing attention to the divide between the “haves” and “have-nots.”
