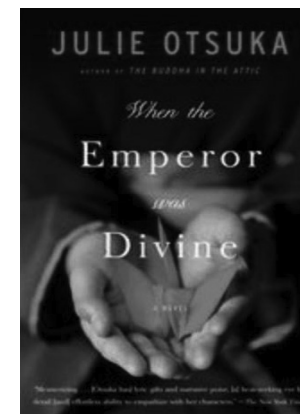
What is the Big Read?
