

Two performances of 'An Inspector Calls' come to Baker City

■ Performances by Elgin's Hale-Turner Little Theatre raise funds for Baker City's Eastern Oregon Regional Theatre space

BAKER CITY — In cooperation with the Friends of the Elgin Opera House and the new Hale-Turner Little Theatre, Eastern Oregon Regional Theatre is presenting a special benefit performance of "An Inspector Calls."

There will be only two shows,

at 7 p.m. Nov. 23 and Nov. 24, at EORT's theater, 2101 Main St. in Baker City.

Ticket sales will help EORT cover the cost of electrical repairs at its performing space, made necessary after a recent inspection by the fire marshal.

Tickets are \$17 for adults, or \$15 for EORT members, and are available at Betty's Books, at Random Resales, online at www.bakerlive-theatre.com and at the door.

Directed by Grant Turner, "An Inspector Calls" is set in an English industrial city in the early 20th



century. A young girl commits suicide and an inspector calls on an eminently respectable British family in the routine inquiry in connection with the death.

The family, closely knit and friendly on the surface, soon shows itself as selfish and cowardly. During the course of the inspector's questioning, all members of the group are implicated lightly or deeply in the girl's undoing.

Tony Carman plays Arthur Birling (a wealthy man) with Xiola Kegal-Grende as Sybil Birling (his wife), Tavi Jacobson as Eric Birling (the son), Avalon Bloodgood as Sheila Birling (the daughter), Cody Wyld Flower as Gerald Croft (the fiance), and Megan Garoutte as Edna the maid.

Inspector Goole is played by Turner, the play's director.
