BAKER CITY — Crossroads Carnegie Art Center is already planning art, exercise and dance classes for the new year. Register now to ensure a spot in the workshops. To register, call 541-523-5369 or go to www.crossroads-arts.org. Crossroads is at 2020 Auburn Ave. Here is a look at the schedule:

RECYCLE IT — FLOWERS, CRITTERS, AND MORE

Ginger Rembold teaches this workshop on Jan. 2 from 1-3:30 p.m. Participants will explore creative ways to use a variety of recycled plastics, metals, woods, etc. Kids can create monsters while adults make flowers. This class is for children age 12 and older, although younger kids can attend with an adult helper. Cost for members is \$10 per person or \$20 for a family. Non-member cost is \$15 or \$30.

MAKIN' MUGS

Shannon Hunt Gray will teach this pottery class in five sessions beginning Jan. 6. It meets Mondays through Feb. 3 from 5:30-8 p.m. This is for ages 21 and older. The instructor will lead participants in wheel throwing mugs with handles. Some experience is beneficial. Cost is \$90 for members or \$135 for nonmembers. A \$25 supply fee covers a 25-pound bag of clay and firing charges.

BEGINNER BALLET 1

Debbie Friedman teaches this class for ages 6-9 on Wednesdays from 4:15-5:15 p.m., Jan. 8 through Feb. 19. This class is for young beginning dancers and focuses on standard positions and simple movements at the barre, in center and across the floor. Cost is \$48 members, \$72 for nonmembers.

ADVANCED BEGINNER BALLET

Debbie Friedman teaches this class for ages 8-12 beginning Jan. 9. It meets Thursdays from 4:15-5:15 p.m. through Feb. 20. This class will focus on correct placement and ballet technique, preparing dancers for more complex movements and some choreography. Cost is \$48 members, \$72 for nonmembers.

BEGINNING ABSTRACT PAINTING

Hillery Lay will offer two opportunities for this class: Jan. 10 or Jan. 11, both from 6-8 p.m., for ages 21 and older. Learn techniques such as dry brushing, color washes and more. Cost is \$16 members, \$24 nonmembers. There is also a \$14 supply fee.

BAL-A-VIS-X (SESSION A)

Nancy Ames will teach this class, which is a series of 300 Balance/Auditory/Vision/eXercises rooted in rhythm using sand bags and racquet balls. It meets Mondays from Jan. 13 to March 2 from 6:30-8:30 p.m. Students need to commit to attend every class. This is for ages 16 and older. Cost is \$80 members. For nonmembers the cost is \$120.

WATERCOLOR ON CANVAS WITH PEN AND INK

Becky Litke teaches this class on Jan. 18 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Students will learn to paint watercolor animals including incorporating pen and ink techniques. Students will learn how to prepare canvas for painting and how to manipulate watercolors. Bring watercolors and the instructor will supply a wrapped watercolor canvas. Extra supplies will be available. Cost is \$40 members. Nonmembers pay \$60 per person.
