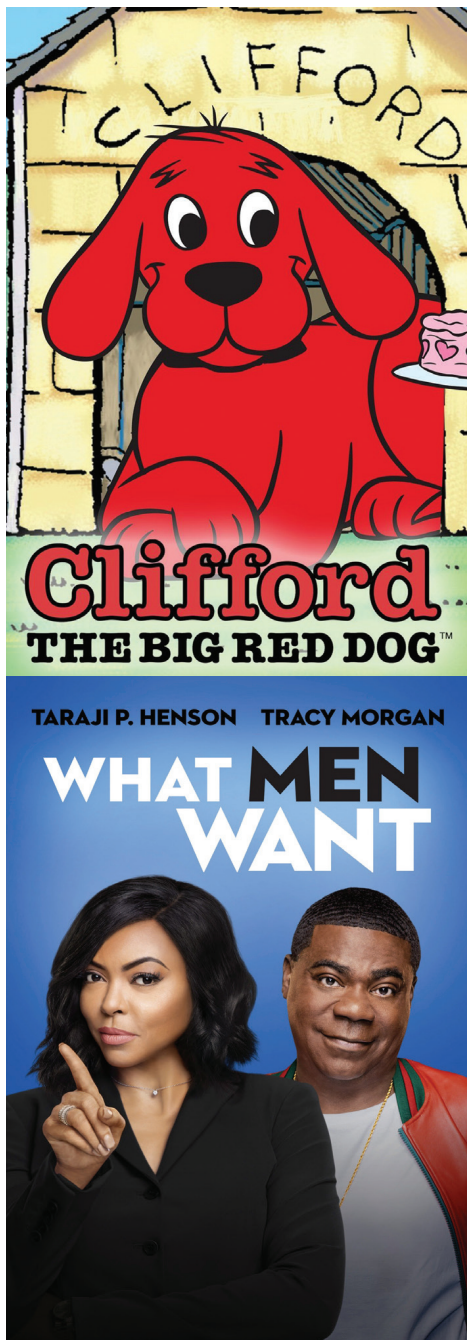

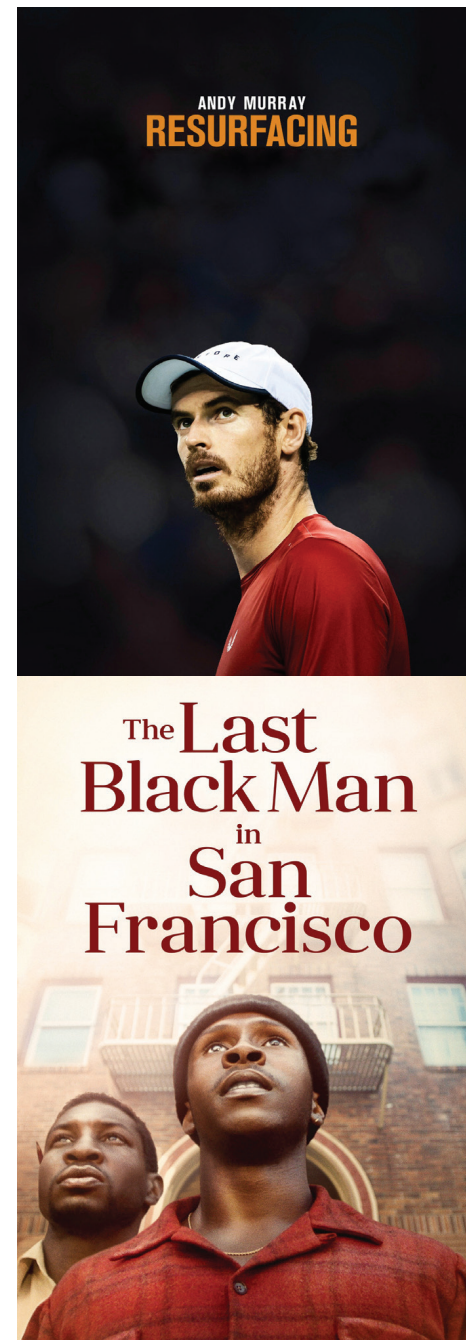

“Movie: What Men Want”

“Empire” star Taraji P. Henson shines in Adam Shankman’s very loose 2019 remake of the 2000 Mel Gibson-Helen Hunt comedy “What Women Want,” with some gender-flipping. The actress stars as Ali Davis, a successful sports agent who nonetheless struggles to advance in her male-dominated profession. After drinking a powerful concoction she gets from a shaman, Ali gains the ability to hear men’s inner thoughts. Aldis Hodge, Josh Brener, Tracy Morgan and Erykah Badu also star.

“Movie: The Last Black Man in San Francisco”

First-time feature filmmaker Joe Talbot made a strong impression with this meticulously crafted 2019 drama about a young black man’s (Jimmie Fails, who co-wrote the screenplay with Talbot) efforts to reclaim his childhood home in a gentrifying neighborhood of San Francisco. Jonathan Majors, Danny Glover, Tichina Arnold and Mike Epps are also in the solid cast.

“Underground Railroad” (date TBA)

Oscar-winner Barry Jenkins (“Moonlight”) directs this limited series based on a Colson Whitehead award-winning novel by the same name. Stars include Thuso Mbedu (“Is Thunzi”), Chase W. Dillon (“First Wives Club”) and Aaron Pierre (“Krypton,” “Brittania”). (ORIGINAL)
