AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT IN THE CITY OF LA GRANDE, OREGON, INCLUDING, THE EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO COLLECT, TRANSPORT OR TRANSFER SOLID WASTE OVER AND UPON CITY STREETS AND FIRST OPTION TO DISPOSE OF, RECYCLE OR RECOVER MATERIALS FROM SOLID WASTES GENERATED OR PRODUCED IN THE CITY; CREATING NEW PROVISIONS; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2630 SERIES 1980, AND ANY OR ALL PRECEDING RESOLUTIONS PRECEDING; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE
This Ordinance will be read for the first time by title only during a Public Hearing on January 8, 2020. The final Public Hearing is scheduled on February 5, 2020 at which time the Ordinance will be read a FINAL time by title only.

Three copies of this Ordinance are available in the City Manager's office for Public review. If adopted, this Ordinance will assure that the Grantor (City of La Grande) grants the Grantee (Waste Pro) the exclusive right and franchise to collect, transport, or transfer solid waste over and upon City streets and first option to dispose of recycle or recover material from solid wastes generated or produced in the city within the Franchise Area, subject to the terms and conditions contained in this Ordinance.
