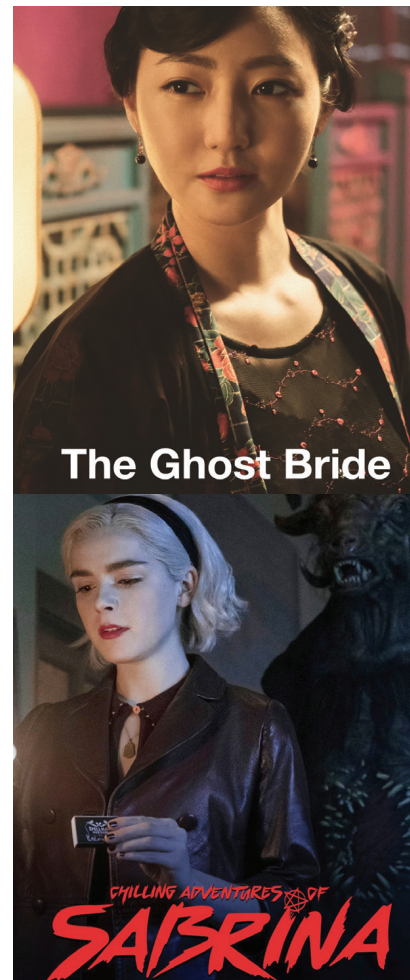
"October Faction"
