than 40 members. West said he'd like to see that number grow — and see the group's geographic range spread.

That's one of the purposes of a planning meeting Tuesday, Feb. 18, at 5:30 p.m. in the Colleen Johnson Meeting Room at the Cook Memorial Library, 2006 Fourth St. in La Grande.

West said the group would like to

schedule trail work trips this summer in the Elkhorns.

Working with the Forest Service, the Trails Association supplies training as well as equipment, including the crosscut saws used in wilderness areas. Chain saws are allowed outside wilderness areas, including much of the Elkhorns.

"We want to supplement what the Forest Service is doing, not supplant it," West said. "I think we're making a significant contribution to trail maintenance."

Sweyn Wall, recreation specialist at the Wallowa-Whitman's Wallowa Mountains office, lauded the efforts of the Trails Association.

We continue to develop partnerships and volunteer opportunities to help maintain trails and facilities in these areas, and the Wallowa Mountains Hells Canyon Trail Association plays a valuable role," Wall said. "We're excited to see their growing ranks and on-theground accomplishments, and we're looking forward to another successful field season together."
