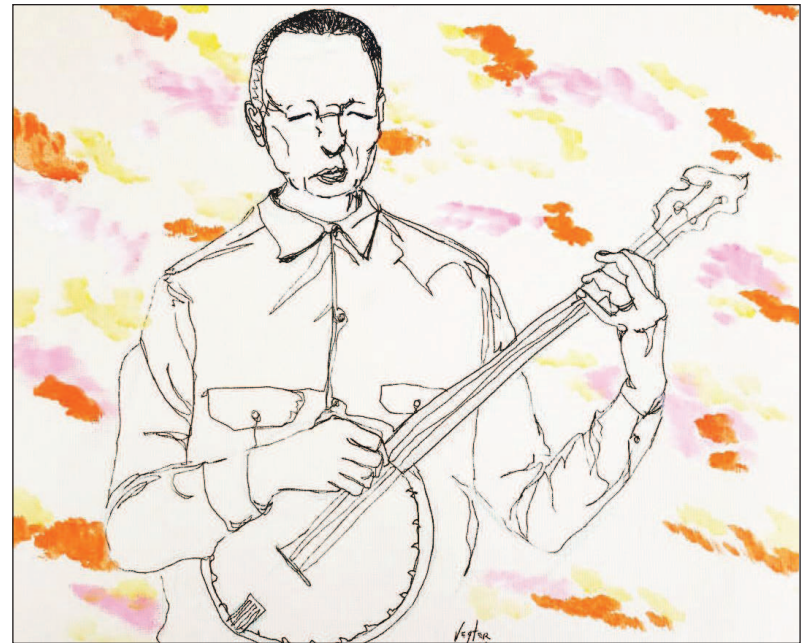
tercolors by Grace Ann Eriksmoen. The opening reception will begin at 5:30 p.m.

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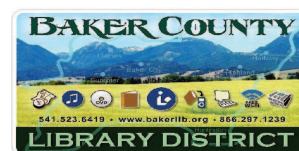
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
