If no one answers, we begin calling emergency contacts, up to and including the police department to do a wellness check. **PEARLS** - The Program to Encourage Active, Rewarding Lives (PEARLS) is a national evidence-based program for late-life depression. PEARLS brings high quality mental health care into community-based settings that reach vulnerable older adults. **Kids Club** – Open 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM, health care workers and first responders given preference.
