1 Persian cucumber, scrubbed, trimmed and thinly sliced

1 teaspoon granulated sugar

Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

2 medium Russet potatoes (1¼ pounds), peeled and cut into 1-inch chunks

2 large eggs

1 carrot, peeled and cut into ½-inch dice

1 tablespoon rice wine vinegar

½ cup homemade mayonnaise or store-bought

1. Place the cucumber in a small bowl and sprinkle with ½ teaspoon sugar and 1 teaspoon salt. Toss to evenly coat and let stand until ready to use.

2. Combine the potatoes and 1 tablespoon salt in a large saucepan. Add enough cold water to cover by 2 inches. Bring to a boil over high heat, then reduce the heat to maintain a light boil. Using a spoon, lower the eggs into the boiling water. Boil the potatoes and eggs together for 7

minutes, then add the carrot. Continue boiling for 5 minutes, then transfer the eggs to a small bowl with a slotted spoon and add enough ice to cover. Boil the potatoes and carrots until the potatoes are very tender, about 1 minute longer. Drain well, then return to the dry saucepan.

3. Set the saucepan over the lowest possible heat to dry out the potatoes. When they're speckled and starting to stick to the pan, about 1 minute, transfer to a large bowl. Sprinkle the vinegar and remaining ½ teaspoon of sugar evenly over the potatoes and toss to coat. Mash about half the potatoes and break up the remaining into smaller chunks. Transfer to the refrigerator to cool.

4. Peel the cooled eggs and coarsely chop, then add to the potatoes. Grab the cucumber slices by the handful to squeeze out all the liquid and add to the potatoes. Add the mayonnaise and gently fold until well-mixed, then season to taste with salt and pepper. Serve immediately or refrigerate to serve cold.

• Make Ahead:

The potato salad can be refrigerated in an airtight container for up to 1 day.

Types of bearded iris are: dwarf and median irises (five classes of these); April iris, which are native to the semi-desert areas of the near East and central Asia.

All bearded irises need good drainage, full sun in cool climates, light shade in hottest areas. Feeding in early spring and after bloom will be enough to keep them happy.

Plant in July or August. Set rhizomes 1 to 2 feet apart with the top just below the surface. Rhizomes grow from the end with the leaves; point that end in the direction you want the plant to grow. Usually watering once every 2 weeks is enough.
