

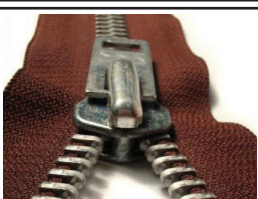

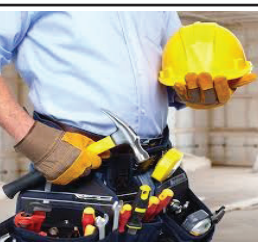

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA GRANDE, UNION COUNTY, OREGON, VACATING ALL OF DOUGLAS STREET, BETWEEN WALNUT STREET AND OAK STREET; JEROME STREET (JERRY STREET), WEST OF WEST STREET; JEROME STREET (JERRY STREET), BETWEEN WALNUT STREET AND CEDAR STREET; JULIUS STREET, WEST OF WEST STREET; JULIUS STREET, BETWEEN WALNUT STREET AND CEDAR STREET; WALNUT STREET, BETWEEN PALMER AVENUE (DIVISION STREET) AND "Z" AVENUE; OAK STREET, BETWEEN PALMER AVENUE (DIVISION STREET) AND DOUGLAS STREET; AND, THE ENTIRETY OF ALL ALLEYS WITHIN BLOCKS 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 AND 12; ALL WITHIN AMENDED PLAT OF GANGLOFF'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF LA GRANDE, UNION COUNTY, OREGON, ACCORDING TO THE RECORDED PLAT OF SAID ADDITION; AND, DECLARING AND EFFECTIVE DATE

The applicable land use regulations are found in Chapter 8, Section 8.10 of the City of La Grande Land Development Code Ordinance Number 3242, Series 2018. This matter will be heard the La Grande City Council on August 5, 2020, and continued to September 2, 2020, for a final decision. Failure to raise a specific issue at this Public Hearing precludes appeal to the Oregon Land Use Board of Appeals. A copy of the application and all information related to the proposal is available for review at no cost, with copies supplied at a reasonable cost. A Staff Report will be available for review seven (7) days before the City Council Hearing, and can also be supplied at a reasonable cost. 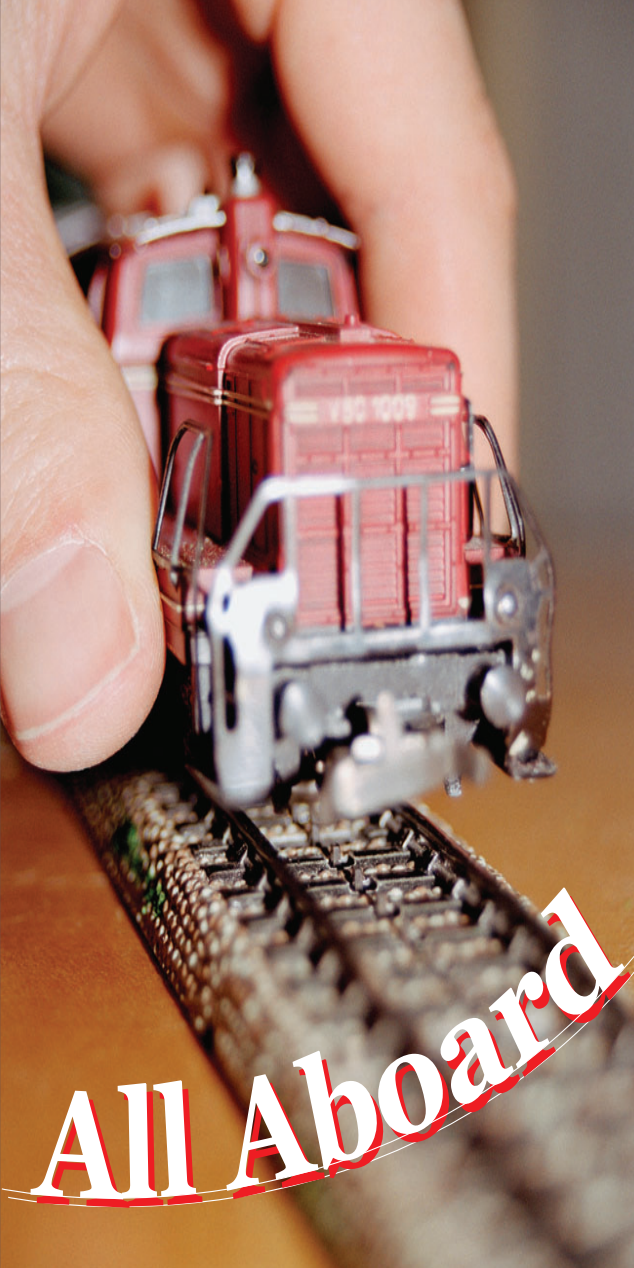
