CASA's home tour turns to gingerbread

BAKER CITY — This Friday, Dec. 4, CASA will unveil a twist on its holiday home tour, which was canceled due to the pandemic.

This year's tour will feature local historic spots created in gingerbread and on display downtown for an easily socially distanced and sweet walking tour.

Talented volunteers have built the gingerbread masterpieces to resemble Anthony Lakes Mountain Resort, the Carnegie Library, Adler House, Antlers Hotel, Geiser Grand Hotel, First Lutheran Church, Churchill School, Ison House, No. 1911, Copper Belt, Baker City Hall, Geiser Pollman Park, Orpheum Theater, Wisdom House, Eltrym Theater, Betty's Books, and the Defrees home.

Maps will be available outside the CASA office, 1937 Washington Ave., Friday. Many of the featured items will be displayed in the window of the building they represent. Others will be placed in windows at various locations in downtown Baker City.

The Gingerbread Walk will be up through Dec. 31.

Another gingerbread display, featuring entries by seniors and children, will be at The Little Bagel Shop Dec. 5-12.

The holiday homes tour is an annual fundraiser for CASA. Those wishing to still donate to the organization can do so by going to casaeo.org. CASA supports and promotes court-appointed volunteer advocacy for children.
