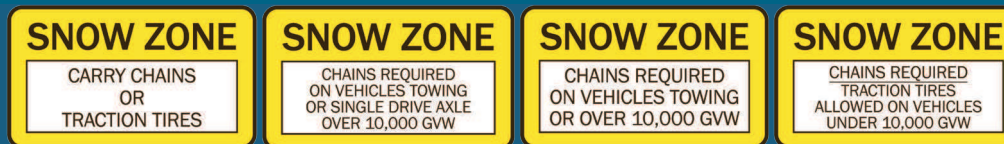

# Oregon Commercial Vehicle Chain Law

Oregon's chain law applies to *all highways* throughout the state. When you drive in winter conditions, you may see signs telling you to carry chains and when you are required to use them.

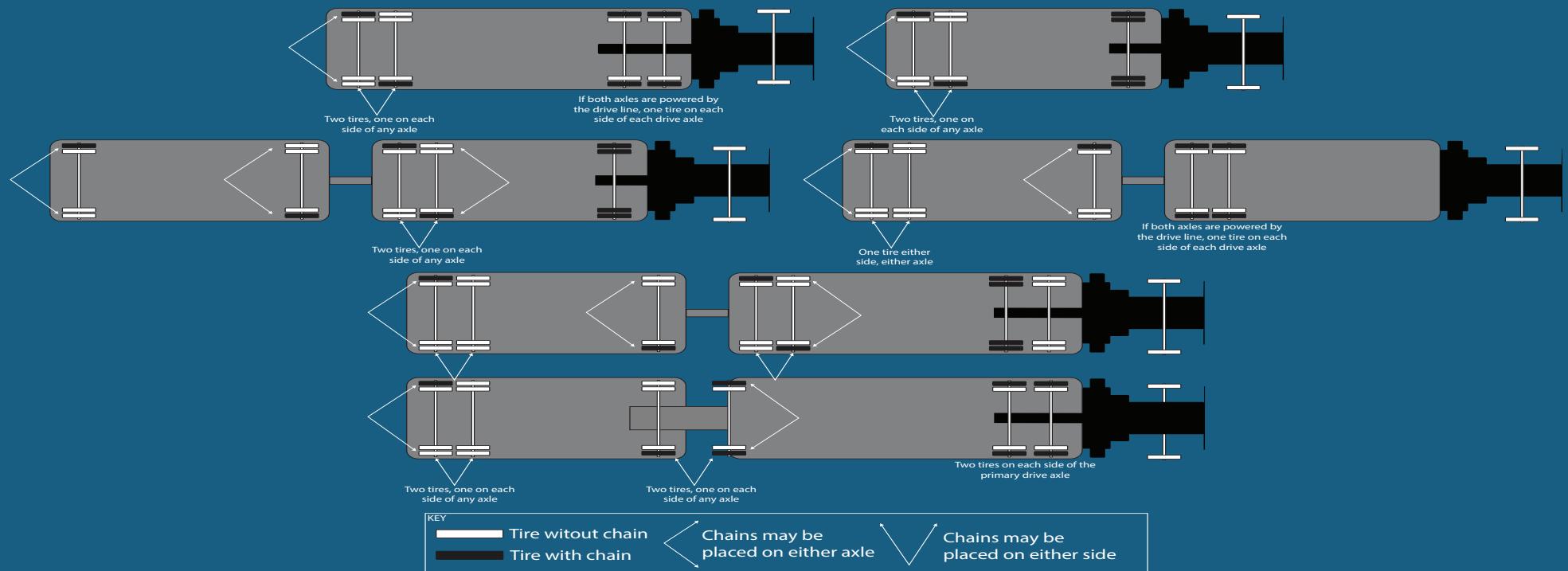


*Chains that are required on commercial vehicles must be placed on:*  
**Drive Axle**

- **Super Single:** on two tires, one on each side
- **Tandem axle primary drive:** two tires on each side of drive axle
- **Tandem axle dual drive:** one tire on each side of each drive axle

## Trailers

- **Two tires, one on each side of any axle**
