

'Who's Your Buddy?' show opens

■ Josephy Center opens new art show next week

JOSEPH — The Josephy Center for Arts and Culture's first exhibit of 2021 — "Who's Your Buddy?" — opens Jan. 6 and continues through Feb. 22.

The center, 403 N. Main St., Joseph, currently is open Monday through Friday from noon to 5 p.m. and Saturday from noon to 4 p.m. Visitors with masks are invited to enjoy the show in person, or experience it from home via a slide show at www.josephy.org.

The theme of "Who's Your Buddy?" celebrates the relationship between humans and their animal companions.

According to the show's curator, René Fleming, "I really wanted to highlight the special companions in our lives through (the) art exhibit. Whether it's a horse, a cat, a hamster or a dog, these animals provide a connection that enriches our lives, no matter what age we are."

The exhibit displays a variety of mediums, from photographs, wood, painting and drawing, clay and ceramics to writing.

"Who's Your Buddy" features 32 local and out-of-town artists, including Ellen Morris Bishop, Jennifer Hawkins-Connolly, Ed Pitts and Aimee Jungmann.

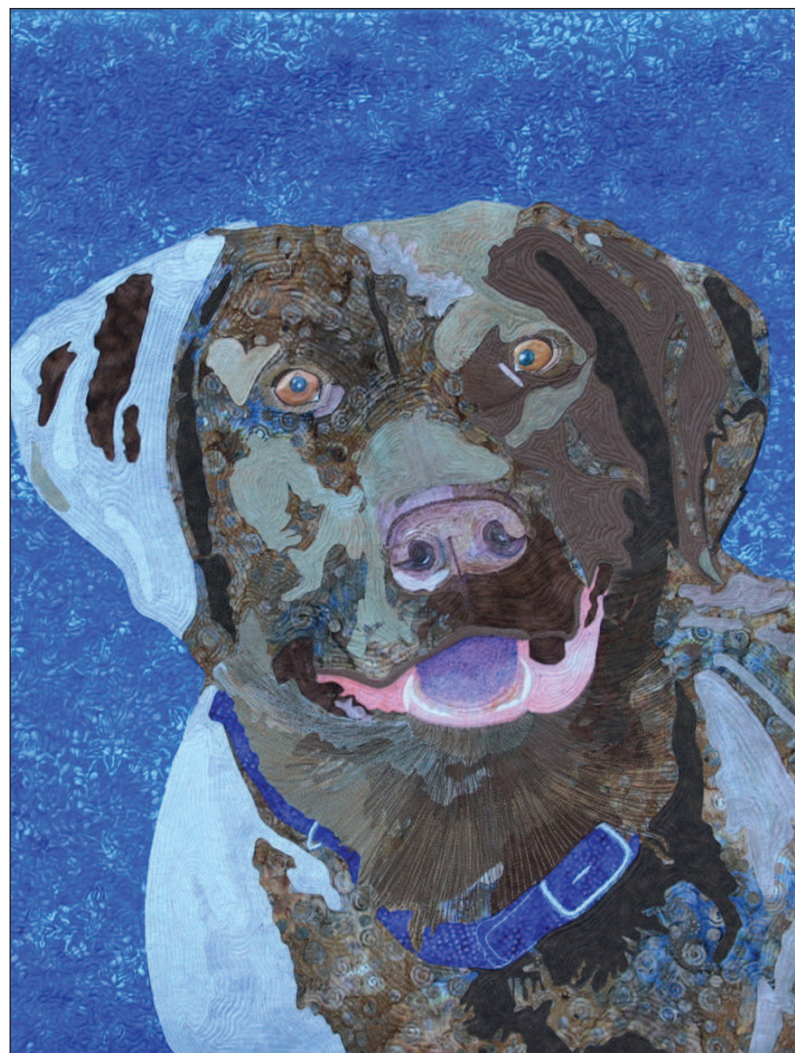

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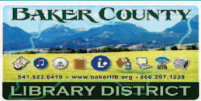
