

# Looking ahead to 2022: Crossroads seeks featured artists for future shows

BAKER CITY — Crossroads Carnegie Art Center, 2020 Auburn Ave., Baker City, is seeking proposals for the 2022 featured artist exhibition in the main gallery.

Featured artists are determined by a volunteer committee composed of artists working in a variety of mediums, art educators, art collectors and the Crossroads art director.

The selection takes place once per year.

## GALLERY SPACE

The gallery space is inside a fully restored 1909 Carnegie Library with 96 feet of movable wall space, a large selection of pedestals and flexible track lighting.

## WHO ARE THE ARTISTS?

The featured artist exhibits represent quality art by emerging, mid-career and established artists from the Eastern Oregon region and larger Pacific Northwest. The center strives to show a broad and diverse range of visual art styles.

Artists are encouraged to submit proposals for new work that was created in the last two years.

Several months per year are dedicated to open shows featuring work of local and regional artists, which limits the number of months available for solo and group shows.

When submitting a proposal for a featured exhibition, artists need to specify a preference for a solo or group show. Each artist will be evaluated individually. Also, the committee, through the jury

process, may group together two to four artists based on complementary styles or mediums.

According to Crossroads: "Artist groups with a clear vision are highly valued and strongly encouraged to submit a show proposal for consideration. Artist groups must designate one artist as the coordinator of the group exhibit."

## SELECTION PROCESS

Submissions are reviewed from digital images of art, as well as the exhibition description and artist's statement.

Artwork submitted for exhibition is expected to be of the same quality, medium and style as presented in the proposal.

Artists who are accepted for a featured artist exhibit have a two-year interval before their proposal will be considered again.

## IF YOU ARE SELECTED

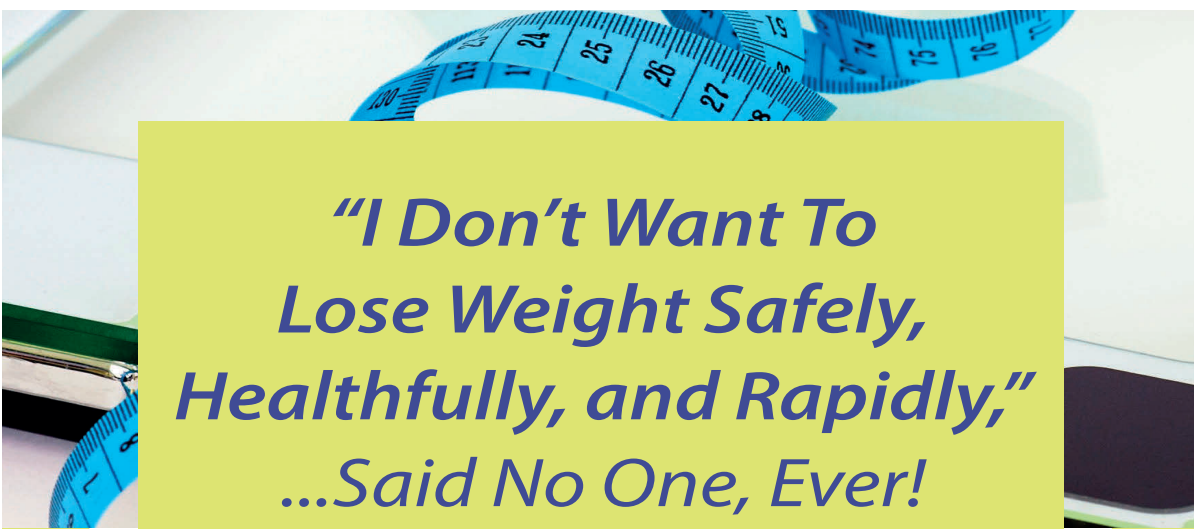
Crossroads operates on a consignment basis and retains a 30% commission for sales during the exhibition, and a 15% standard finders fee for custom orders, such as commissions, placed during the show.

Delivery and pick up of art is the responsibility of the artist.

The artists are expected to attend the opening reception and be available for an informal artist talk.
