In the past year he's helped bands make records, worked at the Range Rider in Enterprise, and worked on construction projects.

Even his living situation isn't normal right now — he usually

lives at the OK Theatre, where he is the venue's production manager. But he's staying with a friend while the theater receives renovations to its facade, plumbing and electrical systems. He said the improvements should be finished later this year. In the meantime, there may be more chances to play music. Earlier this month, Budwig played in Portland — his first show in over a year. He played three outdoor shows with Borst.

"It was fun," he said. "People were really excited."
