Pobanz worked in collaboration with archaeologist Patrick O’Grady and the UO Museum of Natural and Cultural History. Using her own pigments gathered and created from soils gathered all across southeast Oregon she is able to transform the earth to her easel and bring to life her blind contour drawings.

Paired alongside the painstaking process of excavation, Pobanz will also present a small body of work in relation to the pandemic and the Holiday Farm forest fire that took place near her home.
