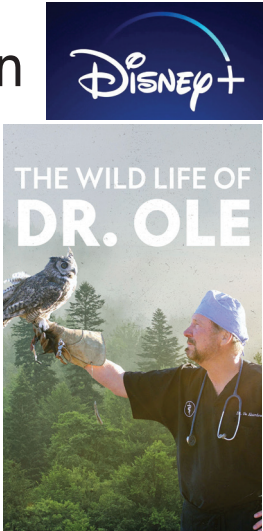
“Thumbelina” (Oct. 22)
