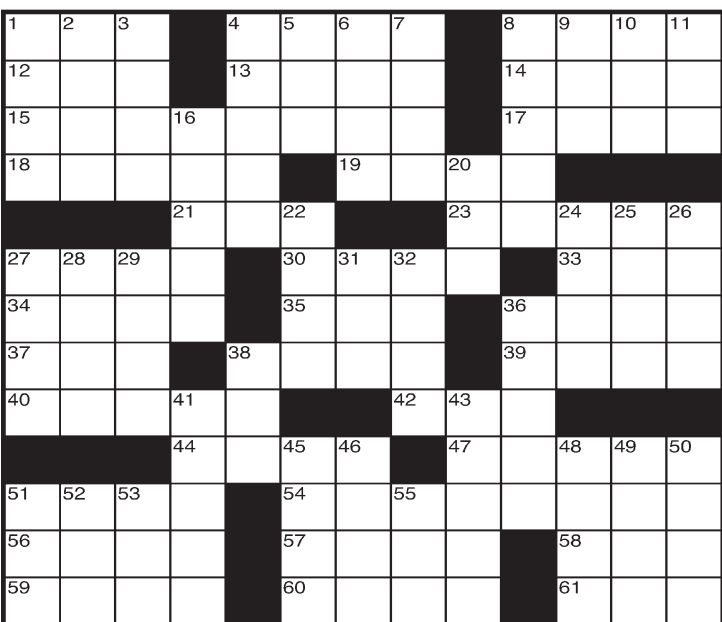

Ranger Districts Seek Input on Backcountry Skiing and Snowboarding Proposal

The Eagle Cap Ranger District, La Grande Ranger District and Whitman Ranger District have received an unsolicited proposal to conduct outfitted and guided backcountry skiing and snowboarding on the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest.
