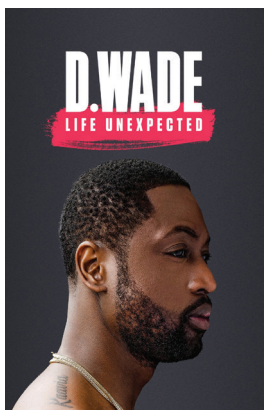
“Something Bit Me!” (Available now)

“Hubble’s Cosmic Journey” (Available now)

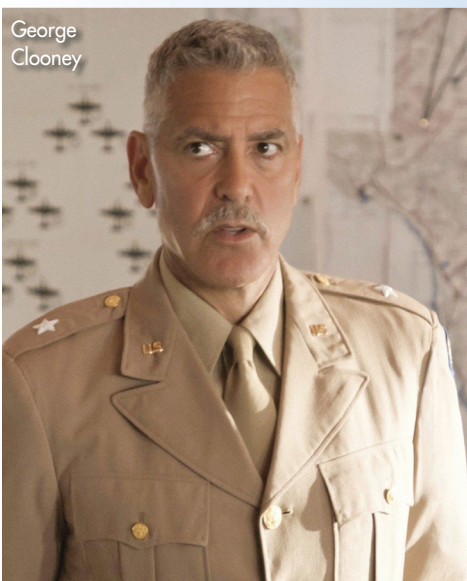

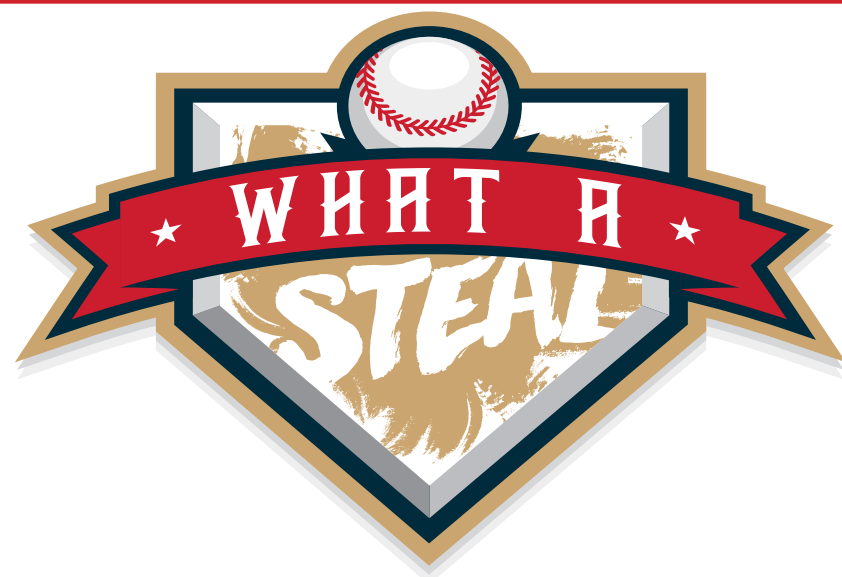
