Project Description: This project consists of finishing and enclosing the phase 2 construction, a 60'x60' building, that is currently an open three-sided pole building, that is an attached addition to the fully enclosed phase 1 construction. The scope of the work involves fully enclosing the phase 2 construction with three walls, (10) roll up doors and frames, concrete door sills, concrete floor, 60' x 60' x 6" thick, with drains, install concrete aprons on east and west walls matching existing apron, installing electric lights, electric receptacle drop cords, installation of at least two outdoor yard lights, installation of a fire wall on the north wall of phase 1, and laying base rock and 3/4" minus driveway rock outside the phase 2 building.
