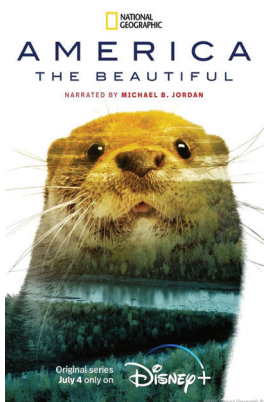

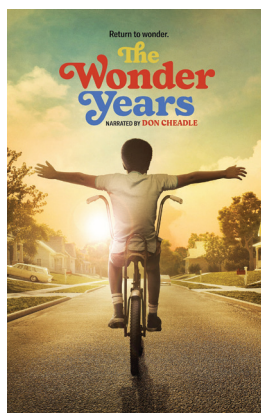
"Ultra Violet & Black Scorpion" (Available now)

The world of Lucha Libre, a freeform wrestling style from Mexico, provides the backdrop for this action-fantasy starring Scarlett Estevez as Violet, a Mexican-American teenager whose life is turned upside-down when a magical luchador mask transforms her into Ultra Violet, a crime-fighting superhero. Fortunately, her uncle (J.R. Villarreal) already is a superhero called Black Scorpion and can train her in using her new powers.



"The Wonder Years: Season 1" (Available now)

Inspired by the Emmy-winning coming-of-age sitcom of the same title that ran on ABC from 1988 to 1993, this comedy series follows Black 12-year-old Dean Williams (Elisha "EJ" Williams) as he and his middle-class family go through life in late 1960s-era Montgomery, Ala. Dulé Hill and Saycon Sengbloh (Broadway's "Eclipsed") play Dean's parents; Don Cheadle narrates the show as the voice of adult Dean.
