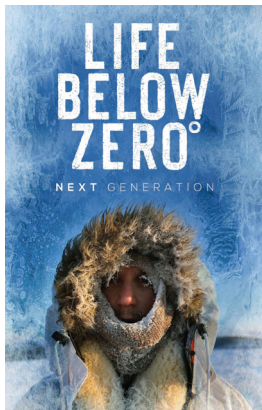
“High School Musical: The Musical: The Series: Season 3” (July 27)
