From Interstate 5:

From the north or south:

- Take Exit 256-Market Street-Salem
- Turn west onto Market Street NE.
- Continue west on Market Street NE.
- Turn right (north) onto 17th St. NE.

• Continue north to 2330 17th St. NE, Salem. The Oregon State Fair and Exposition Center is on the right.

• Free parking is available across 17th Street.
