Comments: Monday's feeder special featured over 750 head of cattle, with an excellent run of bigger feeder cattle and cows. Slaughter cows were higher, with the best of the cows bringing 70 cents, with an average of 58-61 cents per pound. Bulls were steady to higher, topping out at 87 cents, with an average price of 72 cents. The heavy end of the feeder cattle were noticeably higher, with 700-800 weight steers topping out
