THAW WANTS TO BE RELEASED.

Lawyers Will Apply for Habeas Corpus Writ, Deeming He is Insane. Poughkeepsie, N. J., April 21.—The first step toward the release of Harry K. Thaw from the Matteawan Asylum for the insane was taken today.

Jama G. Graham, of Newburg, of Thaw's counsel, made application to Justice Morschauer, at White Plains, for an order directing the superintendent of the asylum to permit Thaw to sign a formal application for a writ of habeas corpus.

The order was granted, and when Thaw has made the application he will probably be brought before a Justice for a hearing to determine whether or not he is sane.

Fleet at Los Angeles.

Los Angeles, Cal., April 20.—The city today began its week's entertainment of the Atlantic fleet. For the next six days officers and men will participate in a variegated program which will occupy nearly every hour of the time. A four-day program for the sailors began at Cribbs Park this morning. Three thousand sailors were given liberty from the ships and were escorted from the beach cities to Los Angeles in free trolley cars.

At the park every variety of entertainment was provided. More than 50 three-round boxing bouts are scheduled to take place there during the week by the Los Angeles Athletic Club. James J. Jeffries is master of all athletic exercises and referee of the boxing bouts. Fencing contests, balloon ascensions, high dives and scores of similar attractions were put on for the amusement of the sailors.

Jury Secured to Try Banker Ross. Salem, Ore., April 21.—A big legal battle in the J. Thornburn Ross case began this morning. When District Attorney Manning offered the first of his testimony in support of the charge that Ross and his associates in the Title Guarantee & Trust Company converted to their own use over \$358,000 of state school funds. The jury has been secured and the opening statements made by the lawyers.

## STATEMENT NO. 1 LACKS A MAJORITY

CAKE DEFEATS FULTON BY 3000 VOTES THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

Kills Is Safe for Congress, Defeating Both Geer and Shepherd by About 2500.

Portland, Ore., April 20.—A majority of the Republican candidates nominated for the Oregon Legislature last Friday ran on anti-statement No. 1 platforms; but because of nine of ten hold-over Senators, the Statement forces will control the State Senate by election of the new Republican nominees for that body. In the House the Statement forces will lack six of a majority should they elect all their Republican nominees.

In joint assembly they will lack three of a majority, should Senator Kay, who is conditionally pledged to the June election choice for United States Senator, act with the Statement forces. If he should refuse to vote for a Democratic United States Senator, in case he won in June, the Statement men would lack four of a majority.

The hold-over Senators pledged to Statement No. 1 are nine in number, or, including Senator Kay, ten. These, together with the eight Statement candidates nominated for the Senate, give the Statement ranks 18 members out of the 30, or two more than a majority. The Statement candidates nominated for the House number 25, and the seats in that body number 60.

It thus appears that out of the 75 Republicans nominated for the Legislature, 33 are pledged to the June election choice for United States Senator, and that should all the Statement candidates be elected, the number, increased with ten hold-overs, will give the Statement ranks 43 out of 90 seats in the Legislature.

The election of four or five Democratic legislators in addition to all the Statement No. 1 Republican nominees would give the Legislature to the control of the Statement No. 1 forces.

H. M. Cake has defeated Charles W. Fulton for the Republican nomination for United States Senator by a majority of approximately 2,250 votes.

Mr. Cake has carried Baker, Clatsop, Columbia, Douglas, Jackson, Lake, Linn, Marion, Multnomah, Umatilla, Union, Wallowa, Wasco, Washington and Yamhill counties, a total of 15, while Mr. Fulton has been successful in Benton, Clatsop, Coos, Crook, Gilliam, Grant, Josephine, Klamath, Lane, Malheur, Morrow, Polk, Sherman and Tillamook counties, a total of 14.

In several of these counties, however, the result is quite close and it makes take the official count to show which candidate has prevailed. It is probable that Fulton will carry Curry and Harney and possibly Wheeler. Lincoln is general conceded to Mr. Cake. The majority for Mr. Cake in Multnomah County is 2,017, a decrease from the promise of the first returns.

The Democratic nominees are: United States Senator—George E. Chamberlain.

Representative in Congress—John A. Jeffrey.

Lulu Goode Acquitted of Assault.

Salem—Lulu Goode and her associates, who horsewhipped the president of the Free Methodist Church here about two weeks ago, have been acquitted of the charge of disturbing a religious meeting. The evidence showed that the meeting had adjourned before the disturbance took place.

Last week a warrant was sworn out for the arrest of Jasper Goode upon the charge of assault and battery alleged to have been committed upon Rev. D. W. Cooke, Rev. W. N. Coffey and Rev. J. P. Lewis, on April 4, the date of the horsewhipping. Another warrant was sworn out for the arrest of Lulu Goode on the charge of assault and battery committed upon Mrs. Hoper, wife of the pastor of the church.

President Roosevelt last week sent to Congress for an appropriation in order to discharge the obligation of the United States to the government of Sweden for the settlement of Samoan claims. The sum involved is only \$375.
