INTENTION IS TO NOMINATE W. J. BRYAN

Champ Clark States in Congress Democrats will Chose Nebraskan Standard-Bearer.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 21.—The intention of the Democratic party to nominate W. J. Bryan for president at the convention to be held at Denver in July next, was declared on the floor of the house today by Champ Clark of Missouri. Some Republicans joined with the Democrats in the handclapping which followed.

A sharp colloquy occurred in the house between Randall of Texas and Dalzell of Pennsylvania. 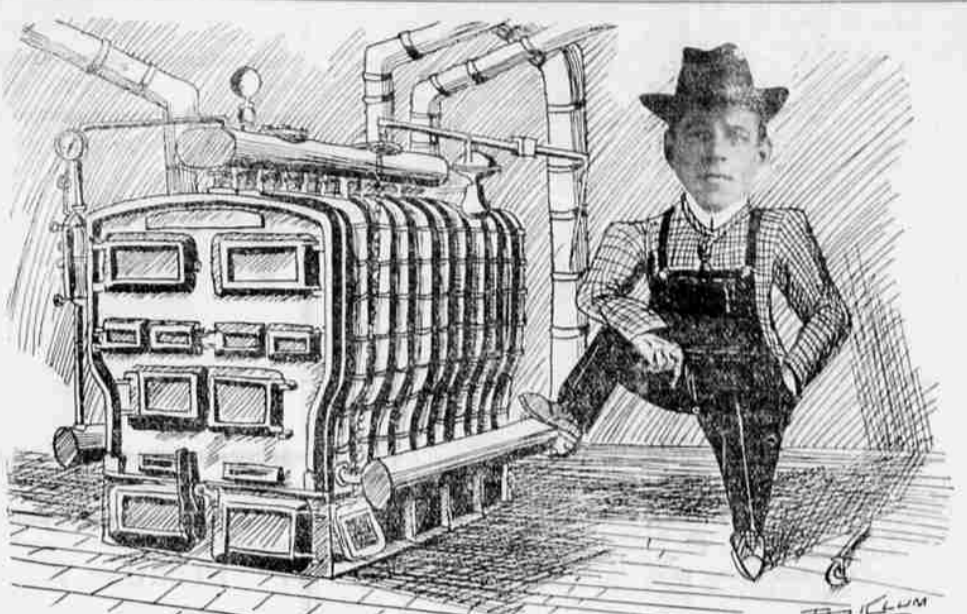

COAL MINERS IN CONVENTION

Annual Meeting Opens With a Thousand Delegates.

INDIANAPOLIS, Jan. 21.—The 19th annual convention of the United Mine-workers of America opened today with 1000 delegates, representing the anthracite and bituminous coal mining districts of the country, and will probably remain in session until after January 30, on which date miners and operators will meet in conference to discuss the agreement. Should the operators decline to meet the miners, the organization will determine the future course of the convention.

Special interest is manifested in John Mitchell, who has been the head of the organization for years and refuses to stand for re-election on account of ill-health. Reading of minutes occupied the entire morning session. Union No. 895 of Belleville, Ill., presented Mitchell with a loving-cup.

SHIP AT SEA IN DISTRESS

Missing Vessel Sighted on Beam Ends— Is Uncontrollable.

SEATTLE, Jan. 21.—A deserting sailor from the Norwegian steamship Tyren, from Bellingham to Australia, reports that the Tyren sighted the missing British ship Hartfield last Wednesday, 40 miles inside of the straits east of Cape Flattery, on her beam's ends, her forward end inverted as a distress signal. She seemed uncontrollable. Seven hours after sighted, the wind changed and the vessel was blown out to sea.

STATE DEMOCRATIC CONVENTION CALLED

The principal business of the meeting was to decide how the nominees for presidential elector and the delegates to the national convention, to be held at Denver, July 7, should be selected. It was decided that the Democratic candidates for presidential elector will be chosen at the general primaries to be held April 17, while the delegates to the national convention are to be elected by a state convention set for June 16, at Portland, at which the choice for electors will be ratified.

The proposed state convention will consist of one delegate large from each county and one delegate for each 250 votes or fraction over 125 cast for Governor Chamberlain at the 1906 election.
