Be It Resolved, by the City Council of the City of Medford, Oregon, the Mayor approving, That the following proposed amendment to the City Charter of the City of Medford be submitted to the legal voters of said city for their approval or rejection at a special election to be held in said city on the 17th day of March, 1908.

Proposed Amendment To Section 72 of the City Charter of the City of Medford.
