PINCHOT WARNS AGAINST COMING TIMBER FAMINE

NEW YORK, March 11.—Announcing that there was no issue before the American people so important in his judgment as the conservation of the natural resources, urged upon congress by President Roosevelt, Gifford Pinchot, forester of the Department of Agriculture, told the American Institute of Electrical Engineers last night that a timber famine in this country was imminent and unless there was a great change in public sentiment the country would have to face in a few years the problem of how to do without wood.
