SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA AND THE ROGUE RIVER VALLEY.

MILLIONS INVESTED IN OREGON'S SHEEP INDUSTRY

Some idea of the importance of the sheep-breeding and wool-producing industry of Oregon may be gained from the report of Secretary Dan P. Smythe.

According to this report Oregon had, in 1907, 1,800,000 sheep of shearing age and 1,000,000 lambs of an aggregate approximate value of \$9,500,000.

When the sheep law went into effect over 10 per cent, or about 250,000 were infected with scab, and now there are only about 170 bucks in Eastern Oregon affected under treatment.

A new sheep disease has appeared within the last few years. It is known as "foot rot" and in the past two years has spread to such extent that it is a menace to the industry.

The most serious menace to the sheep industry, however, according to Secretary Smythe, is the "pestiferous coyote," which animal is creating a wholesale slaughter.

GRANTS PASS PROPERTY INCREASES IN VALUE

Portland is not the only point in Oregon where real estate values are all vanishing rapidly.

The Harry Miller farm, seven miles below the town, sold a few months ago for \$10,000 cash.

The Miller farm was one of 700 acres, belonging to Harry Miller, who became famous as an astute American consul at Newchwang, China.
