WASHINGTON, May 22.- It is ver evident that congress does not propo at the present session at least to repen or modify the timber and stone act it is therefore reason able to expecthat Secretary Gardeld men after the adjournment of congress will entry on his present intention of modifying the regulations for enforcing that law, as to require timbermen bereafter t pay the appraised value for lands take

This all comes about from a varieful study of the timber and stone act something that never occurred during the administration of Secretory High cork, who loudly demounted the unfail ness of the timber and stone act, but meyer awoke to the fact that he had i in his power to correct the injustic Heretafore the interior department is hardly read the timber and stone set and interpreted it to mean that government timber land shall be sold at a flat rate of \$2.50 per a-re, regardless of its value. 
