JAPAN BRINGING ORDER FROM CHAOS

Ambassador Takahira Explains Japan's Cause in Far East—Says Korea and Manchuria Had Allowed Themselves to Become Disorganized.
LAKE MOHONK, N. Y., May 23.—The following is an abstract of the address delivered by Baron Gogora Takahira, Japanese ambassador, at Lake Mohonk conference on international arbitration:
