CASE IS IN SUPREME COURT

Appellant's Brief in Case of State vs Putnam Filed--Await Record

SALEM, Or., Dec. 9.—Appellant's brief in the case of state vs. George Putnam, the famous Medford libel case, has just been filed in the supreme court. The transcript of record has not arrived. The brief recites the familiar incidents of the case and bases its argument on several points, the most important of which is that Judge Hanna of the Jackson county circuit court refused to admit evidence offered by the defendant to show that statements made by Putnam in his paper, the Medford Tribune, about the district attorney and grand jury were true.

The county clerk is at the present time making up the transcript of record in the case, having awaited instructions from the appellant's attorneys to do so. This will be forwarded to Salem in the near future.

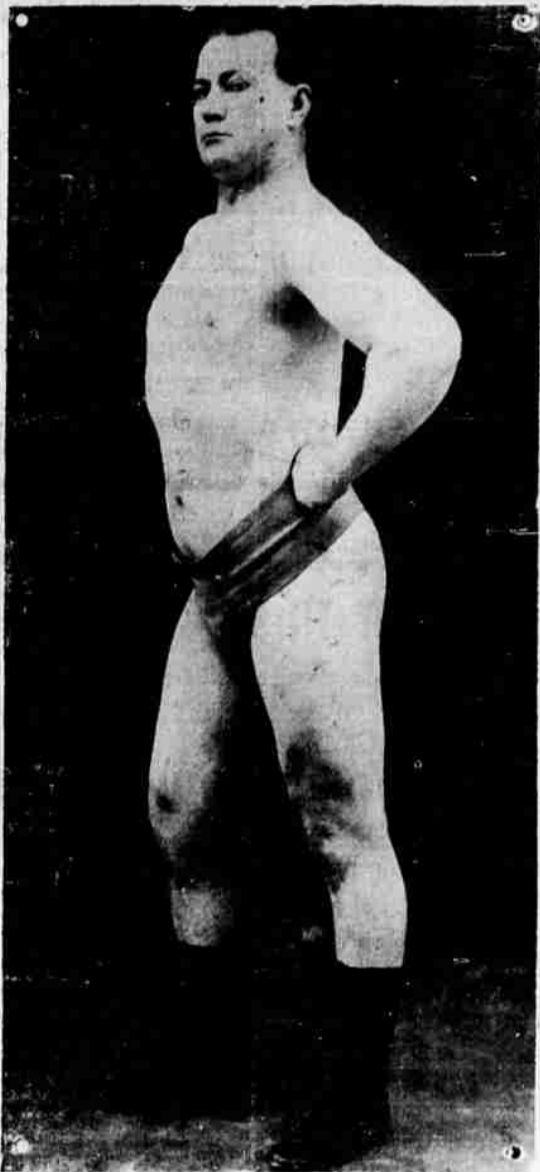
