JUNIOR AERO CLUB TO EXHIBIT IN NEW YORK

NEW YORK, Dec. 18.—That the sad fate that has befallen other would-be aerial navigators has not been sufficient to deter Young America from seeking to experience the joys of flight will be demonstrated during the coming week. The first annual exhibition of the Junior Aero club of the United States will be held at Madison Square Garden and scores of inventive youngsters will show the products of their ingenuity.
 According to the rules governing the exhibition, any boy in the United States under 21 years of age may enter models or drawings of model kites, miniature gliders, aeroplanes, spherical balloons, dirigible or dirigible cars, motors suitable for model work, wireless telegraph or telephones, etc., designed or made by himself. No model shall be more than six feet in length over all and preferably not more than four or five feet. Any kind of motive power may be used.
