Whereas, It is desirable that this question be eliminated from the issues involved in electing a mayor and councilmen for the coming term: Now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the city council of the city of Medford, that the question of allowing saloons to exist under license in the city of Medford during the year 1909 be and the same is hereby submitted to the voters of said city for their election, and that said question be so submitted by placing upon the ballot at the municipal election to be held on January 12, 1909, the following matter, to-wit:

For Prohibition
Against Prohibition.

And be it further Resolved, That in the event that the majority of the votes cast on said question at said election be cast "for prohibition," the sale of

liquor shall not be licensed by the city council during the year 1909, but in the event that the majority of the votes cast on said question be cast "against prohibition," the sale of liquor in Medford shall be licensed as provided by the ordinances of said city.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the city council of the city of Medford, Oregon, December 21st, 1908, by the following votes, to-wit: Merrick aye, Trowbridge aye, Wortman aye, Eifert aye, Hafer absent and Olwell absent.
