

RAILROADS MUST RAISE \$7,500,000, SAYS BROWN

ALANY, Jan. 14.—President W. C. Brown of the New York Central, in an address at the annual dinner of the Albany chamber of commerce, said to-night:

"If the railroads could have pursued and obtained the labor employed in the year 1907 on the basis of prices and scale of wages in effect in 1897, their cost of operation, plus the cost of improvements and extensions, would have been approximately \$676,000,000 less; and had they received for during the business of 1907, their earnings would have been approximately \$90,000,000 greater than they were."

Mr. Brown declares that it will be necessary to raise \$7,500,000,000 for the purpose of increasing and improving railroad facilities during the coming fifteen years.

"The west, and especially the great southwest," he said, "must have thousands of miles of new railroads to make possible the great development of which that region is capable. Texas alone has fifty-five counties in which the whistle of a locomotive has never been heard, and the state of Texas can with adequate railroad facilities and proper cultivation, raise more cotton than is now produced in the United States, or double the annual corn crop of the country."

The railroad construction of 1908, he said, was the smallest in ten years, and that of 1909 promises to be less than in 1908.

ST. LOUIS, Jan. 14.—Mrs. Mina Leher today sued for divorce from Ach Leher. CHICAGO, Jan. 14.—C. R. Danberg, the tallest man in Chicago, served on a coroner's jury last week. He is 7 feet 5 inches long. Information of the interest aroused by the appearance of the giant was communicated to Coroner Hoffman by the deputy who held the inquest over Daniel J. Crego, three years old. Deputy Coroner Hartman says that Danberg is 14 inches taller than Detective George Scrivner, one of the tallest men on the Chicago police force, who is detailed to the coroner's office.
