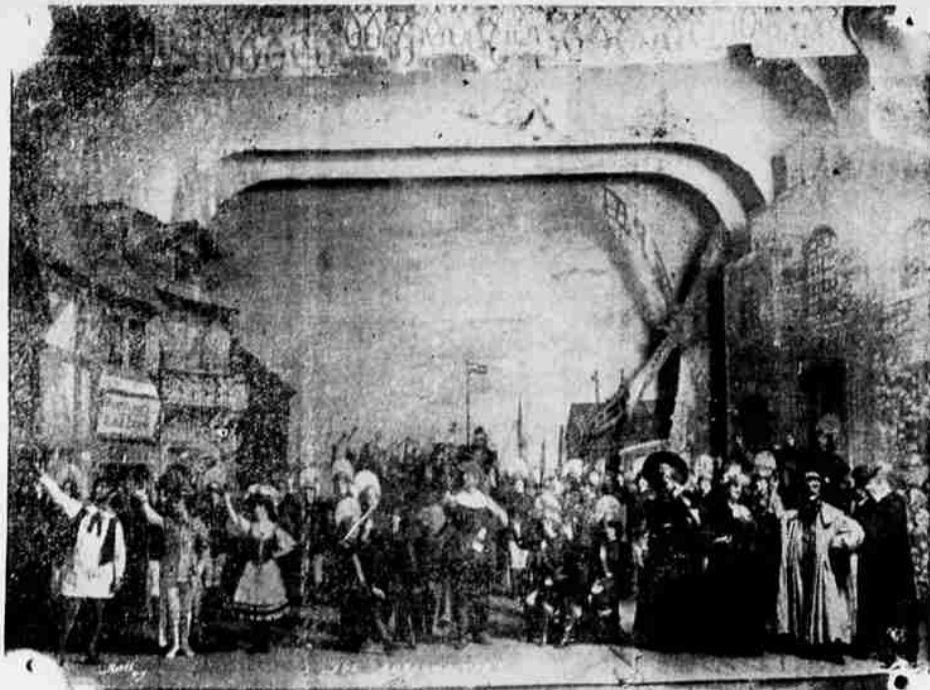

LEWIS WRITES OF PRUNING

Issues Article Dealing With Pruning Work in Apple Orchards of This State

Professor C. I. Lewis of the Oregon agricultural college has issued the following article on apple pruning: It is almost impossible to give hard and fast rules for apple pruning that will apply to all cases.

Be Careful of Your Trees

First of all, let us say you get 1-year-old trees that are not stunted. You had better pay from 12 to 20 cents apiece for 1-year-old trees than to have nurseryman give you the average 2-year-old, because the 1-year-old tree, if properly handled, will mean that you will save yourself much head work and money.

Heading the Tree

In heading the tree soon after it is set means growth and the practice of cutting it off at about knee-high—that is, 18 to 20 inches.

Average Man Should Wait

As a rule, I would not summer prune this year (1909), although it can be done, possibly where men have considerable skill.

keep the open tree nearer the ground. Personally I believe that it is a matter more or less of local conditions and variety. Those tall rangy trees, such as Spitzenberg, Northern Spy, King of Pompano County, etc., I should recommend to be grown by the open system.

Most of the sprawling, rather weak growers, that often tend to grow too low, such as Jonathan, Bellflower and Vinchisp, I should attempt to grow with a center a few years at least. A very strong and desirable tree can be built by allowing a center to grow until it gets to a height of about ten feet and then do not allow it to grow any higher.
