SPECIAL KEY FOR TAFT TO OPEN EXPOSITION

SEATTLE, April 10.—When President Taft gives the signal from the White House that will flash across the continent and start the wheels whirling at the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific exposition June 1st, his hand will press a key of virgin gold, studded with the first nuggets taken from the Discovery claim in the Klondike.

The large nugget, which is set on the key bar, is the first found on bed rock in the Discovery claim, and the twenty-two nuggets which stud the exquisite jewel were in the poke brought out by the discoverer, George W. Carmack.

Today Carmack gave the key into the keeping of the officials of the exposition, by whom it will be sent to Secretary of the Interior Richard A. Ballinger and by him presented to President Taft.

ORDINANCE NO. 188.

Section 2. All applications for licenses made to the city council of said city shall be referred to said committee for investigation and report before the same are acted upon.

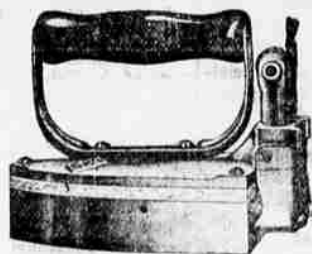
