Six Different Districts Are Provided

DISTRICT NO. 1—All of Medford east of Central avenue.

DISTRICT NO. 2—All of Medford north of Main street and west of Central avenue.

DISTRICT NO. 3—All of Medford south of Main street and west of Central avenue.

District No. 4—All of Jackson county south of Medford, including Ashland, Phoenix, Talent, Barron, all of Klamath and Lake counties and northern California, except Blue Ledge district.

District No. 5—All of Jackson county north of Medford, including Central Point, Gold Hill, Woodville, Trail, Prospect, Wellen, Brownsboro, Eagle Point, Lakeview.
