NEW SULTAN WEAKER THAN PREDECESSOR

is Most Kind to All About Him, Foppish in Dress and Is Very Religious.

CONSTANTINOPLE, May 6.—Mehemmed Rehad Effendi, who has just succeeded to the Turkish throne with the title of Mehmed V., in succession to his brother, Abdul Hamid II., who has been deposed, is, in the opinion of the few persons who have had an opportunity of studying his character, a man of much less mental and political strength than Abdul Hamid. He has since the later's accession been practically a prisoner in Yildiz Kiosk. He was born in Constantinople November 3, 1844, being a brother of Sultan Mehmed Murad V., who was deposed in 1876 and died in 1904. He is the son of Sultan Abdul Medjid Khan.

A person who is well acquainted with the new sultan gives the following sketch of him:

"He is tall and well proportioned, but inclined to stoop. His features are regular, but he has a hooked nose like that of Abdul Hamid. His eyes are blue and his hair and beard are light red. His manners are very gracious and easy, and he is exceedingly generous and kind. He is not at all fanatical, but he is generally fanatical, but he is sincerely religious. He plays unusually well on the piano and he is a great admirer of classic music.

"Like the deposed sultan, the new ruler of Turkey is a good draughtsman and he sketches well. He has two wives and several children, three of whom are boys. His wives are both highly educated and are the daughters of distinguished pachas. At home they dress in the French fashion."

RAILROAD BUILDING IN SOUTH INCREASING

RICHMOND, Va., May 6.—Railroad building in the south is increasing rapidly. Since the first of the year 34 railroad enterprises have been organized or incorporated in the south and southwest, ten in Texas, four in North Carolina, four in Missouri, three in Arkansas, three in Tennessee, two in Oklahoma, two in Louisiana and one each in Alabama, Georgia, Kentucky, Maryland, Virginia and West Virginia.

CURTAILMENT IN LUMBER GENERAL IN WASHINGTON

SEATTLE, Wash., May 6.—Reports from all the timber districts of Washington show that the curtailment of production agreed upon by manufacturers because of stoppage of eastern purchases during the tariff discussion has been general. The big mills are running only eight hours a day now. Stocks of lumber in the east are low and it is expected that the demand will be normal by the middle of June.

real estate fronts in certain instances," the fourth being entitled "A proposed charter amendment of the city of Medford providing for the right of said city to take possession of real estate sought to be appropriated and condemned pending the action for such appropriation and condemnation upon making a deposit into court," and the fifth being entitled "A proposed amendment to the charter of the city of Medford providing for the assessment for special benefits of property in said city owned by any school district of the state of Oregon or by the city of Medford."

Said election will be held on the 10th day of May, 1909, between the hours of 9 a. m. and 5 p. m. of said day.

The city recorder is hereby directed to give notice of said election as provided by the charter in the case of the regular annual election.

The following are hereby designated and appointed as the polling places and the judges and clerks of said election:

First ward—Polling place, room No. 3, Hutchinson & Lumsden building; judge, A. C. Hubbard; judges and clerks, C. W. Davis and C. C. Taylor.

Second ward—Polling place, Home Wash sample room; judge, Chas. D. Hazelrigg; judges and clerks, H. H. Harvey and Wm. Ulrich.

Third ward—Polling place, city hall; judge, G. L. Schermerhorn; judges and clerks, H. A. Thieroff and S. V. Davis.
