1500 MEN DRAFTED FOR PHILIPPINE SQUADRON

VALLEJO, Cal., May 20.—The U. S. S. Vicksburg, which has been under repair at the Mare Island navy yard for a year or more past, was placed in commission there with the usual formalities yesterday, Commander Alexander S. Halstead commanding. It will be some weeks before the vessel leaves the yard, as she has yet to take on practically her entire allotment of stores and provisions. It had been expected that she would go to the Atlantic coast for service, but no orders have yet been received and there is a strong belief that she may be destined for service in Central American waters.

Seven hundred and fifty men from Mare Island and 800 from the Pensacola at the San Francisco naval training station will comprise the draft which is to be taken out to the Philippines by the Buffalo as soon as she can be fitted out for the trip. The unusually large number is due to the fact that the majority of the men now on service with the Philippine squadron have completed their terms of enlistment and are to be mustered out.

VALLEJO, Cal., May 20.—The chamber of commerce and the Merchants' association are preparing to take steps immediately towards having a visit to the Mare Island navy yard included in the program for the entertainment of a number of the members of the house of representatives, who are to pay a visit to the Hawaiian islands during the summer and will be entertained en route by the San Francisco chamber of commerce.

As several of the party are members of the house committee on naval affairs, it is felt that a personal visit to the Mare Island navy yard would prove at once instructive and interesting to them and profitable for this section.
