### THE GREAT PYRAMID.

It illustrates the Wonderful Ability of the Ancient Egyptians.

The cost of the labor and material necessary to duplicate the great pyramid of Gizeh at the present time would amount to considerably more than \$50,000,000, according to a paper read before the Society of Engineers in New York city by E. S. Wheeler, says the American Architect. The cost of the material alone is estimated at \$15,000,000.

This structure, one of the wonders of the world, is founded on solid rock at a depth of about 120 feet below the surface level and rises to a height of 454 feet. Its base covers an area of almost fifteen acres.

Mr. Wheeler's scheme for the construction of this pyramid contained first the setting of a base of granite. This would represent about 2,000,000 cubic yards of material and would cost at least \$10,000,000. The estimate for the superstructure is also \$10,000,000, and it would require 2,772,000 cubic yards of hauled stone and 1,700,000 cubic yards of facing masonry. Wheeler's estimate of labor is 2,700,000 days.

These figures are cited to show the great engineering skill of the Egyptians and the fact that modern construction appeared to be too large for a people whose extant monuments showed their patience and ability in executing structures that would dwarf even the modern structures.
