### TIDE OF HAPPINESS IN SANEST OF AGES

The New Philosophy as Embraced in the New Thought Crusades. Scientific Study.

Under the above caption the July Cosmopolitan presents a very clever sketch of the progress the New Thought is making. It says the greatest reign of the spirit of the world has witnessed has come to this, the sanest of the ages. The article by Harold Bolee is especially recommended to all who would keep in touch with the movement as prescribed by the universities and colleges of the country.

Among others it mentions that the professors subscribing to doctrines identical with or akin to the philosophy embraced in the New Thought crusade, in the Emmanuel movement and in Mrs. Eddy's postulates, are not carried away by sudden mania, but are studying new forces in religion, just as they experiment to determine new reactions in chemistry, is evident to the student who gives attention to the contemporary academic gospel.

Prof. Willet of the University of Chicago is cited as declaring the Bible in constant need of editing in order to choose desirable material for teaching. He also takes the ground that some of the New Testament miracles may yet be understood through the discoveries of science.

The professors assert that the functions of the soul, all the marvelous phenomena of the psychic world, are operating under the sway of universal law. They are inviting mankind again into the fields to which the prophets beckoned the world centuries ago. The choice is either backward to the brute, or forward to the superman. And it is urged in all sincerity that if the philosophic and spiritual Nazarene were to return today, arousing the age with a gospel of power instead of being opposed to the schools, he would receive from many a college in America a call to a chair of psychology.

Bolee says further: "I have been amazed at many of the teachings thus far encountered in my college studies, but I can say in all sincerity that if I had come across Prometheus returned as a doctor of philosophy to grasp new fires from the void, I could not have been more astonished than I was to find the profoundest scholars in our universe lending their philosophic interpretations of life's enigmas to the widespread contemporary movements that declare that diseases of the body and distress of mind and much poverty must pass away when man understands the laws of health and infinite supply. A scientific paper from the University of Chicago declares there is but one force whether it flames from Vesuvius or launches armed masses

across territorial frontiers or sways people by spoken or written word, or wonder-working sound, or is in the soul of great causes.

"The scientific method has been carried over to mental processes and psychology today is the result. Mathematicians, chemists, biologists, geologists, astronomers, jurists and theologians have felt the lack of a unifying unity in their several fields, are joining issues and are finding in philosophy a new gospel. One more mutation, the teaching of Emerson that we are gods playing the part of fools, is taken up by the colleges who insist that just as we have not harnessed the mighty power of the tides, so the forces of the spirit come and go, with man standing idly by."

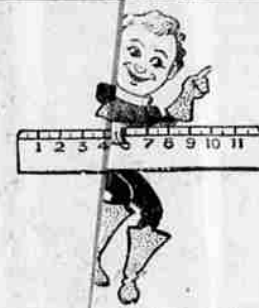
