THREE LARGE SUITS FOR DAMAGE FILED

Wants \$2500 for Being Beaten in Fight—Transportation Company Is Sued.

KLAMATH FALLS, June 14.—Three large damage suits have been filed in the Circuit court of this county in the past week. The smallest of the suits is one where George Kelley sues the four Arant boys for \$2500 for injuries resulting from a fight following immediately on the heels of the celebrated Arant-Harris calf case. The plaintiff alleges that he has sustained permanent injuries from the blows that he received at the hands of the four Arants, all of whom were mixed in the fight.

Another of the suits is brought by H. E. Pointer against the Klamath Falls Land and Transportation Company. In January 1908, plaintiff was thrown from his buggy and sustained a broken leg and other serious injuries. The complaint alleges that the accident was due to the poor condition of the street-car line crossings. Pointer asks for damages in the sum of \$13,000.

The largest of the three suits is for \$25,000. It is a case wherein Charles Deegan sues J. F. Loosely, a rancher, by whom he was employed at the time he was injured by falling from a hay derrick. The complaint sets forth that the 40-foot fall, which caused permanent injuries, resulted from unsafe ropes and clamps used in connection with the machine.

It is very likely that these cases will come up for trial at the term of court which convenes the latter part of this month.

STEEL TRUSTS "HANDS" MUST CUT OUT DRINKS

They're Not Permitted to Leave the Mills Now Until Their Day's Work Is Done.

PITTSBURG, June 14.—The United States Steel Corporation has taken a determined stand against its workmen drinking liquor. Within the past week there have been posted in all the big mills of the Pittsburgh and Ohio districts notices that workmen once entering the mills to work will not be allowed to leave until they are through their day's work. There is no reference to "booze," but the managers and superintendents speak their minds plainly.

The corporation has found that much time has been lost daily by the workmen leaving for a few minutes to go out and get a drink, perhaps several times a day. In addition to this those in direct charge of the men say they do not do as good work when they are allowed to fill themselves with drink, and so the order is imperative.
