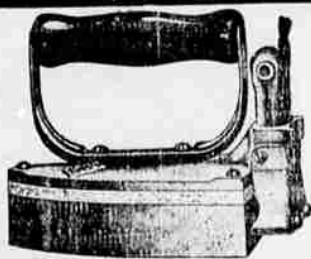

ORDINANCE NO.

An ordinance assessing the cost of main and lateral sewers in Sewer District Number 8 in the City of Medford against the property directly benefitted by said sewers and adjacent thereto, and providing for the entry thereof in the Docket of City Liens of said city.

The City of Medford doth ordain as follows:
 That no protests having been filed against the assessment of the cost of main sewer laterals in Sewer District Number 8 of the City of Medford, notice thereof having been given to the respective owners of property thereby affected as provided by the Charter of said City of Medford, the council has considered the matter and hereby declares the cost of said sewer and laterals to be assessed against the respective parcels of property in the respective amounts herein set opposite said respective parcels, which said parcels of land are hereby declared to be directly benefitted thereby in such respective amounts in such proportion, all as hereinafter set forth in detail.
