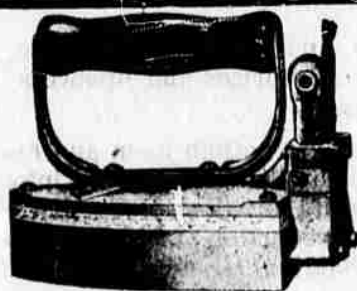

CITY NOTICES.

ORDINANCE NO. 199.

An ordinance providing for the execution and delivery by the City of Medford, Oregon, of a bond in the penal sum of Ten Thousand Dollars, to M. F. Hanley, his heirs and assigns, conditioned upon the payment to said M. F. Hanley, his heirs and assigns of all damages and compensation that may be awarded to him in that certain action pending in the Circuit Court for the State of Oregon, in and for the County of Jackson, for the purpose of appropriating certain real-estate belonging to and in the possession of said M. F. Hanley, wherein said City of Medford is plaintiff and said M. F. Hanley is defendant.

The City of Medford doth ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Medford are hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the City of Medford, to execute to M. F. Hanley a bond in the form following, and to cause the same to be delivered by filing the same with the Clerk of the Circuit Court, for the State of Oregon, in and for the County of Jackson, in the action pending in said court wherein City of Medford is plaintiff and said M. F. Hanley is defendant, which action is brought for the appropriation of certain real property owned by and in the possession of said Hanley, and to cause said bond to be served on said M. F. Hanley in accordance with Statute.

In the Circuit Court for the State of Oregon, for the County of Jackson.

City of Medford, plaintiff, vs. M. F. Hanley, defendant: Bond.

This indenture witnesses, that the City of Medford, Oregon, a municipal corporation, as principal and W. S. Crowell and W. I. Vawter and J. E. Enyart as sureties, are held and firmly bound unto M. F. Hanley in the penal sum of Ten Thousand Dollars, for the payment of which sum well and truly to be made, unto the said M. F. Hanley, his heirs and assigns, the said parties hereto do hereby bind themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns firmly by these presents.

The condition of this obligation is nevertheless such, that whereas, the above named City of Medford has heretofore commenced the above entitled action in the above named court against the said M. F. Hanley for the appropriation of the real property owned by and in the possession of the said M. F. Hanley, described as follows, to wit: An easment and right of way for laying under the surface of the ground a pipe line and for ingress thereto and egress therefrom, on and over the following described land: A strip of land 11,244 feet long and 30 feet wide, the center line of which is described as follows: beginning at a point on the west boundary line of section 25, township 36 south, Range 2, east of Willamette Meridian, in Jackson county, Oregon, 952.9 North of Southwest corner of said section; thence by the following bearings and distances as staked out and marked out from said point, being station 2, 64.1 to the boundary fence between said Hanley and Dick Slinger, being station 113,031, a total distance of 11,244 feet.

Bearings and Distances—N 25 degrees, 03 minutes W. 35.9 feet; N 40 degrees W. 436.9 feet; N 36 degrees,

Total feet, 11,244.

Said pipe line to be laid beneath the surface of the ground and the ditch in which it is laid to be properly back filled and tamped and the surface of the ground of said tract to be restored and maintained by the city to its present level by said city.

And whereas, the City of Medford desires to commence the immediate construction, operation and maintenance of said pipe line:

Now, therefore, if said City of Medford shall pay all damages and compensation that may be awarded to defendant in the action, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force.

In testimony whereof, the said City of Medford has caused these presents to be executed on its behalf by its Mayor and Recorder, and the seal of the said City of Medford to be hereto attached and said sureties hereto have hereunto set their hands and seals the 17th day of June, A. D. 1909.
