CONDITION OF CALIFORNIA CROP

Pears Are All Shipped—Peaches Rapidly Falling Off

The California Fruit Distributors, under rate of August 24, issued the following trade letter: The following gives number of cars of deciduous fruit shipped to all points by all members of this company for the week (7) days ending Monday night, August 23, 1909.

Peaches, 121 cars. Less than one-half as many peaches were shipped out this last week as during the previous one. There is not much to offer in this line now except Clings, although there are a few Picketts.

Pears, 145 cars. Pears also show a material dropping off in shipments. There are but few Bartletts available.

Grapes, 342 cars. There has been a considerable gain in the grape movement during the last seven days and the next week will show a still further increase.
