## THE REPUBLICAN CONVENTION.

### The Good Ticket Nominated Justifies the Support of All.

The Republican Convention for the nomination of city officers was held last Monday night in the City Hall. Never before in the history of Ashland has so much interest been shown in local politics as was shown at this convention, a vote of one hundred forty-eight being cast in the first ballot. The house was called to order at eight o'clock by Robt. Taylor. E. V. Carter was elected chairman; F. D. Wagner, secretary, with C. H. Gillette as assistant.

J. P. Dodge was made the unanimous candidate of the convention for Mayor, and a more capable man could not have been chosen.

The most enthusiasm was shown in the nomination for Marshal. The choice of the convention was C. P. Jones, who received a ballot of one hundred eight votes against the united strength of thirty-four votes for the other nominees. Mr. Jones has seen much service on the policeman's beat, and justly merits the confidence of our respectable, law-abiding citizens—not the gamblers, however, who, we are informed, are going to run our present "excuse for a marshal."

The ballots were cast twice for Street Commissioner, B. R. Willits receiving the nomination in the second ballot.

E. V. Carter, Milton Berry and J. A. McCall were made the unanimous nominees of the convention for the offices of Treasurer, Recorder and Surveyor respectively.

The ward nominations for Councilmen are as follows: 1st ward, H. C. Myer; 2d ward, C. B. Crisler; 3d ward, J. W. Schmidt.

The Republican ticket throughout is a good one, and should be given the support of every citizen who is interested in our city's welfare.
