John D. Lewis, a colored lawyer, who recently died in Philadelphia, has bequeathed a portion of his estate of \$100,000 as a fund for the "Lewis Political Bureau of Civil Rights," to secure to colored citizens or colored persons in the United States their civil rights.

The story published that many Italians employed on the line of the new railroad being constructed in West Virginia were killing and maiming their fellow workers. On the 10th of April there was a narrow escape from riot, and over 100 of the men were dismissed by the contractors.
